Vision

In 1977, the Catholic-Jewish Women's Conference (CJWC) was founded to promote fellowship and mutual understanding between our two vital traditions, and for forty years their annual conference has drawn women from across the greater Los Angeles region into deeper dialogue and friendship. Catholic and Jewish women friends from the South Bay have attended these conferences, and in 2016, we were inspired to begin a forum of our own -- we decided that a similar gathering was needed in the South Bay where Catholic and Jewish women could meet, hear stimulating speakers from both faith traditions on relevant topics, exchange ideas, learn about our faith traditions, and, best of all, kindle new friendships.



Speaker

Rabbi Dr. Rachel Adler

Dr. Rachel Adler is professor of Modern Jewish Thought and Judaism and Gender at Hebrew Union College, at the Los Angeles campus. Adler was one of the first theologians to integrate feminist perspectives and concerns into Jewish texts and the renewal of Jewish law and ethics. Her approach to God is Levinasian and her approach to gender is constructivist.

Sr. Tracey Sharp, SCRH

Sister Tracey Sharp, SCRH has been a member of the Sisters of Charity of Rolling Hills for 30 years. A graduate of Loyola Marymount University, she also holds a licentiate in fundamental theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. She is her community's vocation director, and she works in the Matrimonial Tribunal of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles.
